Hush Foundation's Healthcare plays tackle the biggest issues in the culture of health care today – patient safety, communication and staff interactions. Written by award-winning playwright, Alan Hopgood AM, the plays use real stories to highlight the challenges faced by patients, families and staff in health care. Hush Health Plays have been performed all over Australia and internationally to thousands of people and can be performed in any venue - from the staffroom, to the board room and the large scale conference arena.



Hush have partnered with the team at PocketMedic to share their innovative and award winning series of 10 films about the daily challenges of people and carers living with dementia. 
